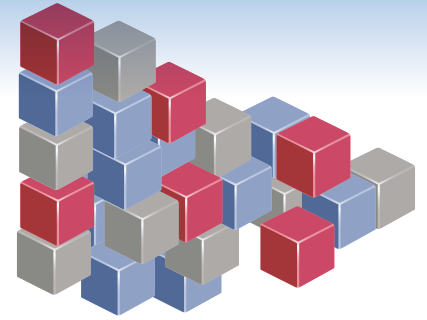


“Learn From The Best”
