The outcomes of successful implementation spans achieving highest quality, low cost, and shortest lead-time.

We also offer an additional half-day **Manufacturing Shop Floor tour** at the Toyota vehicle manufacturing plant located in Altona, Victoria. Participants will see the Technical Tools in action in combination with the Managerial Role to gain a deeper understanding of what it takes to sustain an organisational culture designed to surface and solve problems.
